The AFL-CIO is organizing a Workers First Caravan for Racial and Economic Justice to take place largely on June 17. It is a massive national day of action to confront the three crises facing America: a public health pandemic, an economic recession and social upheaval caused by institutionalized violence against people of color. By joining this event we will be joining thousands of union members and allies taking to the streets to urge Congress to pass the HEROES Act, a COVID-19 relief package that would make sure every worker retains their health insurance, paycheck and more.

There will be caravans across all 50 states and Puerto Rico will be participating in solidarity actions as well. In Washington, D.C., a 1,000 car caravan will make its way through the city. The D.C. caravans begin in Arlington VA and Silver Spring, MD. At both of these staging sites a team will be present

to assist in placard distribution and provide each driver with the route that will be followed to the Capitol. Currently in New York State there are caravans in the following cities: Buffalo (June 17), Albany (June 14), and Kingston (June 20). The NYS caravans require you to bring your own signs. 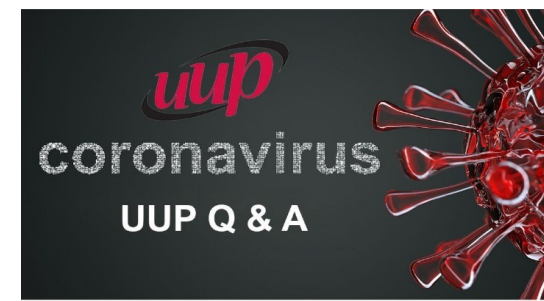
