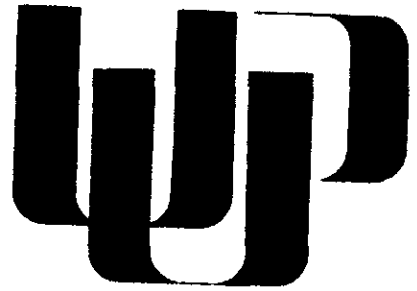

Joe Baldwin read a letter from UUP Central Office with regard to centralizing travel arrangements through that office for members using air travel or car rentals on UUP business.

A discussion on work load was conducted. Fred Miller's letter to C. Craven and the latter's response to it were read.

-F. Miller made the point that administration was changing exceptions to policy not the policy itself.

-J. Carney and F. Miller will write a letter to C. Craven asking how we arrived at 300 generated credit hours as a normal load for instructional faculty when previous student/faculty ratios were 85 students per faculty member. Both the proposed and previous definitions of normal load were based on teaching 12 hours, according to administration memos.

D. Mancke's termination was discussed.

-She was notified of termination after her eligibility date for the early retirement incentive had passed.

-J. Smyth will give S. Livingston particulars of the situation and circumstances, since discussions on temporary service people have been in progress in Albany.

Decision on location of our local UUP office still pending F. Miller inquiries.

Dissatisfaction of promotion procedures relating to a bargaining unit member were relayed by J. Carney

-possible implications of age discrimination
-principal recently had memo from administrator regarding handling of a student problem at end of Spring 83 semester
-a similar situation with principal was dealt with last year by F. Miller when promotion was not given. C. Brush was consulted.

-this year's promotion was apparently turned down by dean's committee - this memo dated two days after previously mentioned memo was received.

-we will wait to see memos, hear outcome of principal/Brush meeting, and details of dean's Advisory Committee hearing
